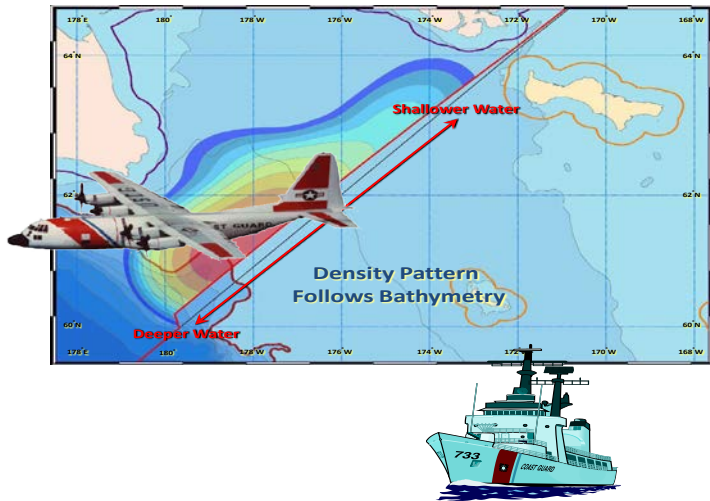

- No suspected incursions

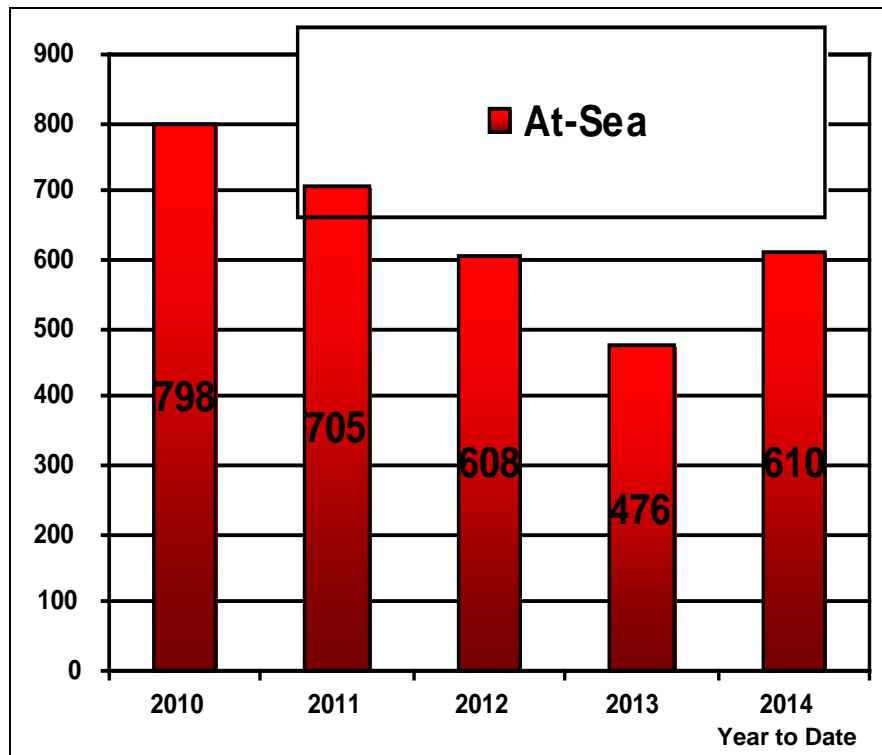
USCG Patrol Efforts on MBL:

 - Sighted 12 FFVs in RS waters

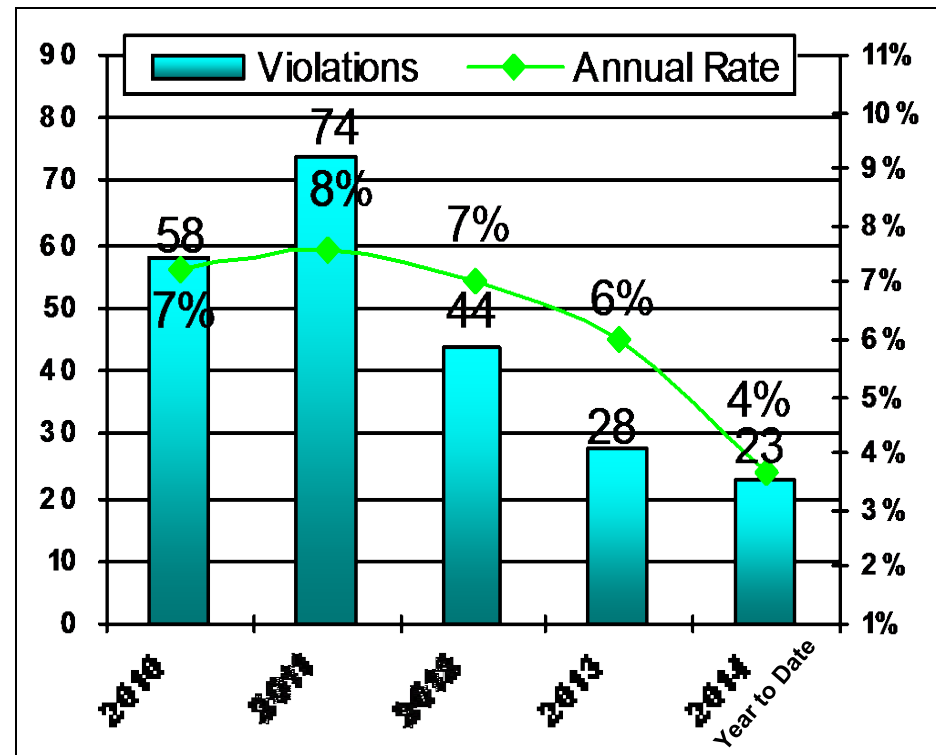

Commercial Fishing Vessel Safety Enforcement

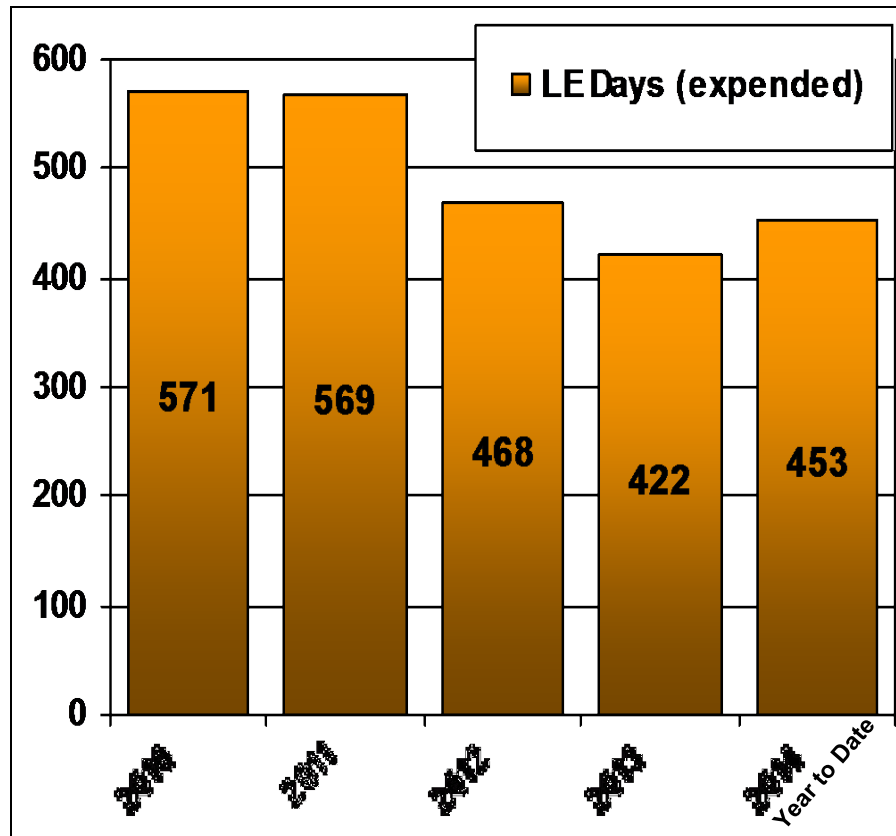
- CGC MUNRO conducted 19 boardings on crab vessels

- Coast Guard helicopter deployed to Cold Bay for search and rescue standby



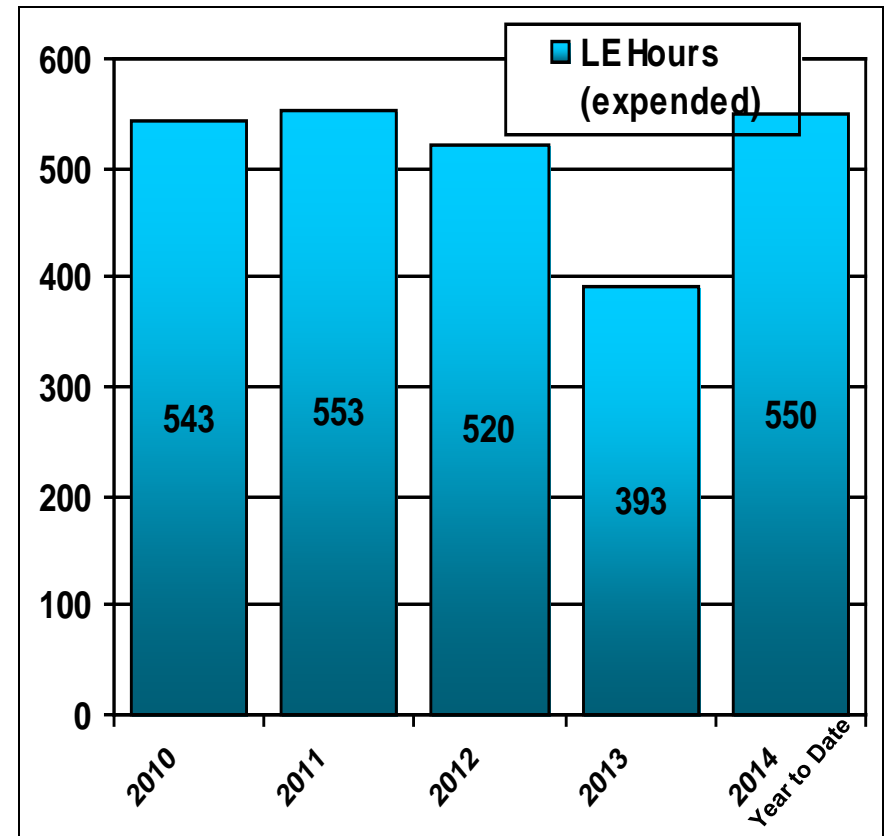


Major Cutter Days and HC-130 Hours
