### Search and Rescue December 2015 – April 2016

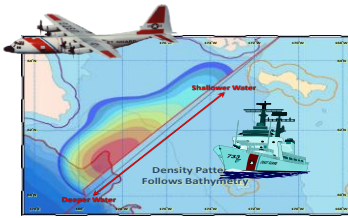
27 F/V SAR Cases

- No activity December to February

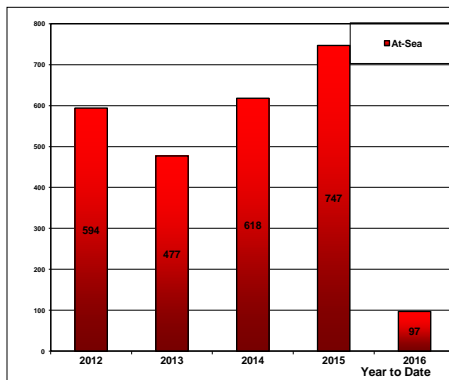
### USCG Patrol Efforts on US/RS MBL:

- 1 patrol flight by CG C130

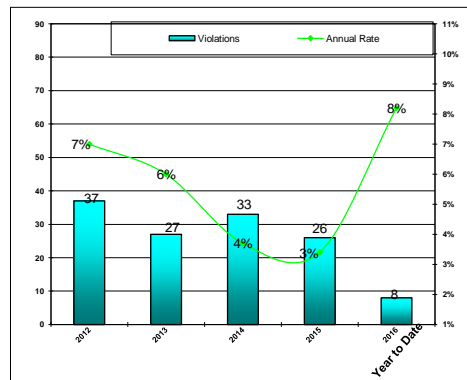


## Fishing Vessel Boardings & Fisheries Violations

### **IFQ Halibut & Sablefish**

- Season opened on 19 March
- 01 boarding of IFQ halibut vessels
- No fisheries violations observed

### **Charter & Recreational/Subsistence Halibut**

- 08 boardings of Recreational/Subsistence halibut vessels
- No boardings of Charter halibut vessels
- No fisheries violations observed

### **Commercial Fishing Vessel Safety Enforcement**

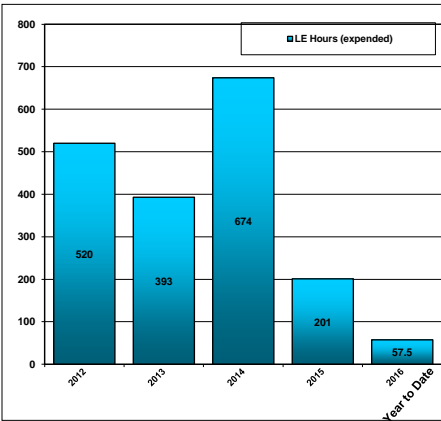
- **CGC WAESCHE, CGC MELLON, CGC ALEX HALEY, and CGC MUNRO conducted 26 boardings**

- **Forward Operating Location (FOL) stood up in Cold Bay for MH-60 helicopter SAR standby and law enforcement patrols until 25 March 2016**



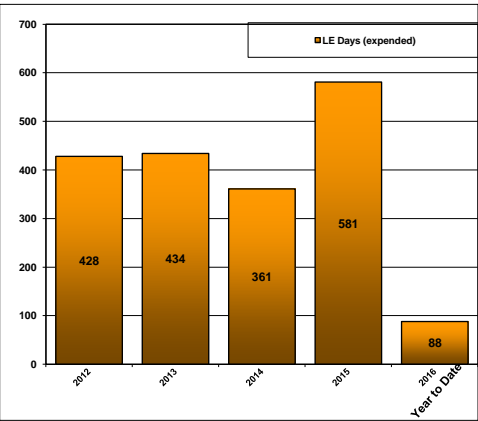


# Major Cutter Days and HC-130 Hours
